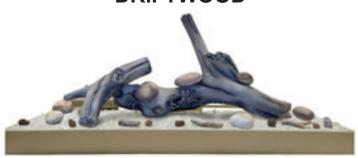

LOG SET & DECORATIVE ROCK PLACEMENT

ATTENTION: The position of the crushed glass and ceramic fiber accessories is critical for the safe and clean operation of this fireplace. Sooting and other problems may result if the crushed glass and ceramic fiber rocks are not properly placed in the fireplace.

LOG, EMBER AND CRUSHED GLASS PLACEMENT

- Remove barrier screen and glass door on fireplace using instructions from the fireplace manual.
- 2. Remove the burner cover.
- 3. Push up pin 4, as shown in Figure 4.

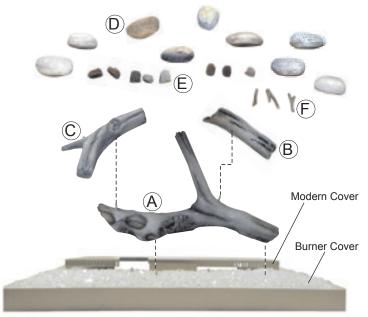
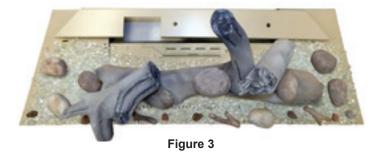
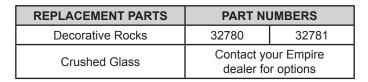

PIN LOCATIONS FOR LOG PLACEMENT

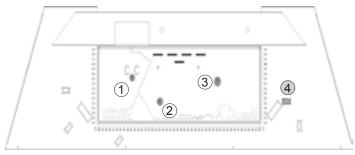

GLOWING EMBERS (place in shaded area only)

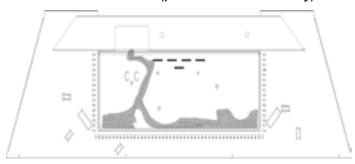

CRUSHED GLASS (place in shaded area only)

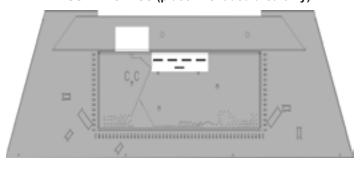
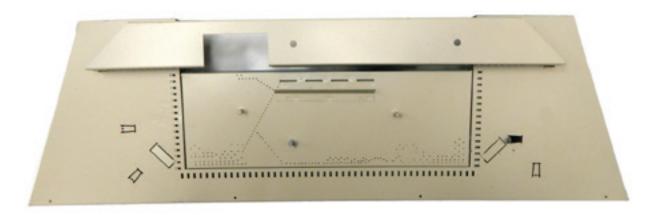

STEP 1. Push up pin on the right shown below. Replace burner cover inside fireplace.

STEP 2. Apply a thin layer of Crushed Glass over the burner surface and cover. See image below.

STEP 3. Place (Log Index Letter A) onto pins 1 and 4. See image below.



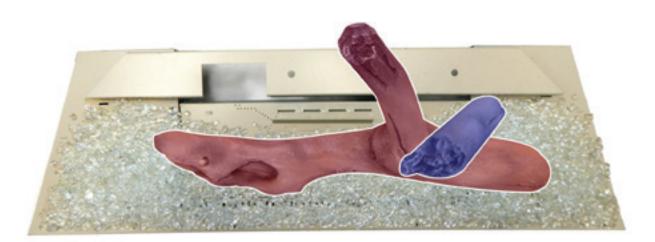

STEP 4. Place (Log Index Letter B) onto the right pin on log A and angle behind log A. See image below.

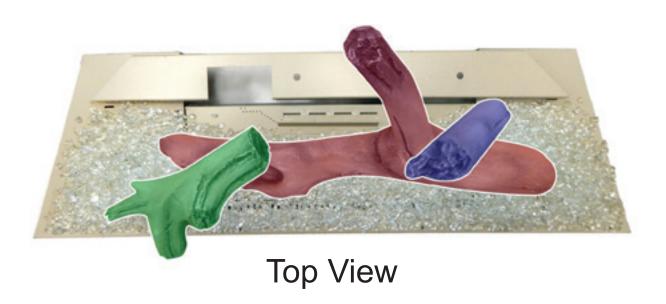


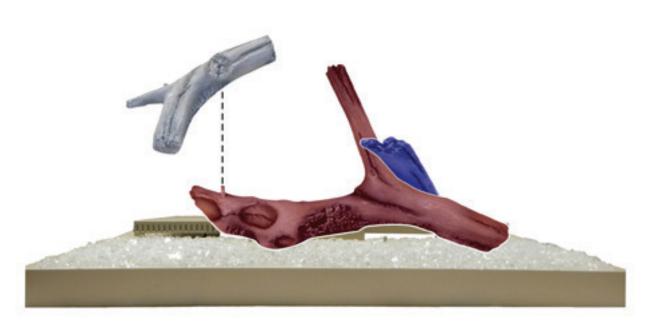

STEP 5. Place (Log Index Letter C) onto the left pin on log A and angle in front of log A. See image below.

STEP 6. Place (Log Index Letters D, E, F) Decorative Rocks and Sticks on top of crushed glass. See image below. Glowing embers may be placed along the circular ports on the burner as shown in Figure 5.

STEP 7. This completes the assembly of the decorative media and log set. Replace glass door and barrier screen as indicated in the fireplace manual.

Warranty Parts

Warranty parts will need a proof of purchase and can be ordered by your Service Person or Dealer. Proof of purchase is **required** for warranty parts.

All parts listed in the Parts List have a Part Number. When ordering parts, first obtain the Model Number and Serial Number from the name plate on your equipment. Then determine the Part Number (**not** the Index Number) and the Description of each part from the following illustration and part list. Be sure to give all this information . . .
